1 Features

Mahjong for Nokia Series 60 is a very realistic game simulating the classic and popular Chinese tile game Mah Jong in Asia especially in Hong Kong, Taiwan, Mainland China, Japan, etc.

Mahjong is also a very good starting tool for foreigner to learn how to play Mah Jong.

Also,

- support languages of English, Chinese and Japanese even on English Nokia 7650/3650
- 4-player table as real game
- playing rules conform to Cantonese style
- realistic human speaking sound effects
- animated computer players
- changeable computer players based on difficulty

2 System Requirements

- Nokia 7650 with firmware 3.12 or above, or Nokia 3650, minimum 600k storage, 80k free memory to run
- A PC desktop with PC Suite for Nokia 7650/3650 installed (Optional)
- IR/Bluetooth between your PC and the Nokia 7650/3650

The application has been tested on Nokia 7650 (English) with software versions 3.12 and 3.16

3 Installation

3.1 Using PC Suite for Nokia 7650/3650

- a) Download the appropriate installation file to your desktop PC
- b) Connect your Nokia 7650/3650 to the PC using Infra-Red/Bluetooth (refer to your Nokia 7650/3650 manual)
- c) Run the file for your preferred language:

MahjongNS60_101_EN.SIS	English version
MahjongNS60_101_TC.SIS	Traditional Chinese version
MahjongNS60_101_JP.SIS	Japanese version

For trial version:

MahjongNS60_101_Trial_EN.SIS	English version
MahjongNS60_101_Trial_TC.SIS	Traditional Chinese version
MahjongNS60_101_Trial_JP.SIS	Japanese version


- d) Start PC Suite for Nokia 7650/3650
- e) Click on "Tools -> Install device software" and select the appropriate downloaded file to install. Click "Open" and the following screen will pop up to start the installation




- f) When you see the above screen, just click "Install anyway" to continue the installation
- g) The following screen will pop up. Click "Next >" to continue



- h) You will see another "Select disk" screen, if you have MMC memory card installed (for Nokia 3650 only), the drive E will be shown, or drive C only in Nokia 7650 or 3650 without MMC inserted. It is recommended to choose MMC (Drive E) to install the software to save main memory space.



- i) Then you will see another "Please read..." screen which displays the license agreement for you to read. You can either click "Yes" to accept it and proceed with the installation OR click "No" to abort the installation
- j) If it is the first time to run the **Mahjong** program, registration code is required.



Note:

Trial version does not require registration code, and certain limitation is applied to the trial version. Please refer to Readme1st.txt

Your registration code is given based on the IMEI (a 15-digit unique serial number on the GSM phone) on your Nokia 7650. You have to supply the IMEI to m-internet to generate the registration code. IMEI will be shown by pressing ***#06#** on your phone keypad, write it down and send it via email to support@m-internet.com for assistance. Make sure you can install each copy in one device only!!

3.2 Using Infra-Red/Bluetooth Connection


Alternatively, you can directly "beam" the installation file to your Nokia 7650/3650 via Infra-Red or Bluetooth. It will be stored as a New Message in the inbox of your Nokia 7650/3650.



Open the New Message and the installation will start automatically. During the installation, you will be prompted to read the license agreement. You can choose to accept it and proceed with the installation OR reject it to abort the installation.

4 Removing Mahjong

Once installed, an entry called "Mahjong" will be listed in the Applications Manager program under the "Tools" folder. Select this entry and use "Options->Remove" to remove the Mahjong application.



5 Playing Mahjong

5.1 Starting Mahjong

Press the Application Launch icon  (7650) or  (3650).


In the Application menu, navigate to the icon  Mahjong and press trackball button to start the game.



5.2 Aim of the game

You have \$30,000 as your score and you have to win against your opponents until he/she loses all scores.

When you win your opponent, the difficulty increased and there are 14 opponents in total to take your challenge!!



Legend:

A – Number of tiles left


B – Wind (East/South/West/North), where the wind is placed also indicating your position (East/South/West/North)

5.3 Keys used during the game

Trackball button (Move Left and Right) – select which tile to discard OR to respond to action of Chow/Pong/Kong/Win



Pressing Trackball button – to confirm action of taken out/chow/pong/kong/win



5.4 Minimum and Maximum Points

Minimum is 1 point and maximum 10 points, rules confirm to Cantonese Mah Jong style.
